TUITION AGREEMENT

- 1. I understand the \$200 per student pre-pay discount is available on full pay tuition commitments only when paid in full by June 15, 2019.
- 2. I will turn in my payment information (either ACH or post-dated checks for the year) by June 15, 2019. I acknowledge that a \$250 late fee will be applied to payment plans submitted after June 15, 2019.
- 3. I have read the tuition late payment policy in the parent handbook and agree to pay my tuition on time and in full.
- 4. I have read the early withdrawal policy in the parent handbook and understand that I am signing a contract with the following financial obligations:
 - Withdrawal prior to the first day of school: tuition is owed for July and August.
 - Withdrawal prior to November 1, 50% of total amount is due.
 - Withdrawal prior to January 1, 75% of total amount is due.
 - Withdrawal on or after January 1, 100% of total amount is due.
- 5. I understand that this contract does not include my music program fee, to be billed during the fall semester.
- 6. I understand that Hot Lunch meals are not included in the yearly tuition fees, but can be purchased by cash, check or monthly ACH withdrawals.
- 7. I understand that PRWS reserves the right to involve a 3rd party collection agency if the terms of this contract are not met.



FUNDRAISING / RAFFLE AGREEMENT

I/We agree to participate fully in the PRWS fundraising requirement of \$500 per parent. Please note this does not include Annual Giving, Holiday Faire, Scrip, volunteerism, or other activities. This requirement can be fulfilled by:

1. Participating in the PRWS annual raffle (selling raffle tickets). Please note that any unsold raffle balance will be billed to you with payment due to meet re-enrollment eligibility for the next school year.
