The Development Director helps provide PRWS with additional sources of revenue and support through the cultivation of relationships, clear and insightful communication, community building, and donor retention to support the school's fundraising programs. This position calls for a data-driven, highly entrepreneurial, dynamic individual who possesses development experience in major gifts, fundraising, planned giving, campaign planning and implementation, and appreciation for Waldorf education.

The Development Director reports to the Administrator, and works collaboratively with administrative colleagues, Faculty, and the Board of Directors to support the school's development and fundraising goals.

Strong candidates will have demonstrated experience in development, preferably in a non-profit and/or educational institution; excellent written and verbal communication skills; ability to articulate the mission of Pleasant Ridge Waldorf School and Waldorf education; a Bachelor's degree or higher.
