This afternoon assistant will support the work of the class teacher by reading stories and encouraging an afternoon rest for the first grade students.

This is an hourly position, paid bi-monthly. Hours will include 1 hour per day, 5 days per week (1:55-2:50pm) during scheduled school days. Hourly rate starts at \$15 per hour. For specific details regarding this position and duties, a conversation between the first grade class teacher and administrator will be scheduled.
