

Beginning 2025-26 School Year

Pleasant Ridge Waldorf School is seeking a skilled piano player to accompany our Eurythmy classes, beginning in the 2025-26 school year. Eurythmy, the art of making sound visible in movement, was developed by Rudolf Steiner as a performing art, a pedagogical practice, and a therapeutic activity.

We are looking for a pianist who can play music to accompany classes taught to children in grades 1 through 8. This is a part-time position, offering 10-14 hours per week, during the school year. Classes generally happen between 10:55 a.m. and 2:50 p.m. and you can expect 2-3 classes on each day that you work. A class lasts 45-55 minutes.

Qualifications and Benefits

Applicants should be able to sight-read classical music—although in general you will be given music in advance to practice before class. Preference will be given to candidates with experience playing as an accompanist for Eurythmy classes. The hourly rate starts at \$15 per hour. Free hot lunch provided Monday through Thursday.
